

# The Nature of Theology

- Systematic Theology Definition: The comprehensive, holistic interpretation of Scripture for the purpose of intimately knowing and rightly worshiping God.
- Topics of Systematic Theology: Prolegomena–Bibliology–Theology proper–Angelology–Anthropology–Hamartiology–Soteriology–Christology–Pneumatology–Ecclesiology–Israelology–Eschatology

# The Nature of Theology

- Systematic Theology vs. Doctrine
    - Theology is a verb—something we do
    - Doctrine is the result of this process
  - Goal of Theology:
    - Theology is a process
    - doctrine is the result
    - a transformed life is the goal
    - a life lived in worship

  - Theocentric—God-centered
  - Doxological—glory-centered
  - Displays consistency of Scripture—inspiration-Centered
  - Personal—transformation-centered
